- 2. **Motion** by Anderson, second by Doll to certify the open meeting law agenda requirements. Roll call vote was unanimous.
- 3. **Motion** by Doll, second by O'Kane to approve the Board minutes from May 21, 2019. Motion carried.
- 4. **Motion** by Doll, second by Miller to approve the monthly bills. Roll call vote was unanimous.

5. President's Report

• Munson was absent but she told Doll that David and Miller volunteered to help with a basket fundraiser. They will need others to help with the fundraiser as well.

6. Fundraising Ideas

- O'Kane talked to Mike Bowar at the Bowling Alley. There are a lot of dates open in October, November and December for a fundraiser.
- We need to find a date to do the fundraiser, a Sunday in October might be a good choice.
- We could also do a meat raffle at the bowling alley.
- Baskets could be displayed at the Library and then taken to the bowling alley.
- Another fundraising idea is to do a food stand at WalMart.
- The money will go to buy edging for the landscaping.
- Additional funds could be used to buy chairs. If there is a large event at the library we have to borrow chairs from City Hall.
- We might want to ask people to donate money to buy a chair. We could use the website GoFundMe. We talked about DonorsChoose.Org but that is for public schools.

7. Policy for items in Catholic Charities Collection

- The Library board is concerned about putting the mailboxes in the parking lot. We don't believe there is a purpose to move them from where they currently are.
- Our objections will be passed on to the RDA.

11. Director's Report

- The staff meeting was about ideas for adult programs.
- The refinished table is now in the genealogy room.
- Statistics are great right now. They are down a little from last month but still higher than last year.
- Ashmore is buying Launch Pads instead of Playaways.
- Landscaping is coming along. The library bought two spruces, the other plants were donated.
- The Library and the Police Department will be splitting a donation of products from 3M.
