- Approval of February 28, 2023, Library Board Meeting minutes. Motioned by DuCharme and Second by Erickson. Motion Carried.
- 4. **Approval** of Monthly Bills. Motioned by Doll and Second by Teynor. Roll call unanimous. Motion Carried.

5. President's Report

- All the leaves for the tree are ordered from Sports World.
- The library will be ordering a plaque in honor of Garth Frable's retirement. The cost will be covered by President Linda Munson. Garth was a great supporter of the library while employed with the city of Prairie du Chien. We wish Garth the best in his retirement.
- The library made over \$866 dollars from the book sale held on March 17th and 18th.
