

COOPERATION WITH OTHER LIBRARIES

1. The Library Director and the Library Board of Trustees recognize that no single library can meet all the demands in its community. Libraries working together, sharing their resources and services, can more nearly meet the full needs of their users.
2. The Board of Trustees and the Library Director will be alert to opportunities for cooperation with other libraries to strengthen the services and resources of the library.
3. The public library exists to serve the community.
School libraries exist to serve a curriculum.

The public library cannot perform the function of school or other institutional libraries. Providing textbooks and curriculum material is generally the responsibility of the schools.
